ballet clothing, baggy or loose-fitting tops, school uniforms, denim clothing (gymnasts will not be permitted to participate in class)

Gymnastics Fees

Our Club is a not-for-profit organisation managed by a Committee of Volunteers. It relies on the timely payment of fees in order to operate.

A courtesy reminder that gymnastics fees are charged per term and are due and payable by the requested due date. Failure to pay will result in a gymnast being suspended from participating in classes until full payment has been received.

An annual registration fee is charged to all gymnasts which includes annual compulsory insurance. This, together with gymnastics fees, is payable within 2 weeks of enrolment with the Club. Gymnasts will not be able to participate in classes unless payment has been received.

Refunds

Non-attendance by a gymnast (family holidays etc) does not qualify for a refund or credit.

Any fee credit resulting from a change of class requested by you throughout the term will be applied in the next term's invoice. Please note that this does not apply to Term 4 fees.

All requests will be taken into consideration, however, a refund or credit is not guaranteed.
